SUBJECT: NCPDP Version 5.1 Compound Segment FAQs

On **June 6, 2009** the “Compound Segment” became active allowing electronic processing for New Hampshire Medicaid multi-ingredient compounds claims.

Since implementation, the Medicaid and First Health offices have received questions regarding coverage of bulk products for compounded medications and regarding rejected claims. Please note the following:

1. Are bulk products commonly used for compounding covered?

Yes. Several manufacturers that produce compounding agents participate in the Federal Drug Rebate Program. A list of participating manufacturers is given:

2. When I enter a prescription for a compounded claim, it is being rejected.
